What can I report?

Quid Pro Quo Harassment, Sexual Harassment, Sexual Assault, Dating Violence, Domestic Violence, Complicity, and Exploitation and Sex-Based Stalking can all be reported. These are included in GSC's definition of Title IX Prohibited Conduct.

Where can I make a report?



I want someone that will support me, but who isn't required to report it

Who can I talk to?

I want to talk to someone who will inform the Title IX Coordinator with or without further action by me

Confidential Employees

Confidential employees are not required by law to report Title IX incidents. Examples include: the Student Health Center personnel and Counseling Services, as well as administrative staff in these offices.

Responsible Employees

Responsible employees are required to report any incident of prohibited conduct. Examples include: most GSC staff, CLs, and faculty.
